Hi Pastor Joshua and Friends at the Point!

We hope this letter finds you well. We're well and really enjoying the fall colors! We've been busy sharing about our ministry at churches in New York, Michigan, Illinois and Pennsylvania. We've spoken around twenty times, with many of the churches being new to us.

We can see the Lord's hand and favor in opening doors, as it is often difficult to find churches that will allow you to visit and share. Fortunately, people are very excited about what we're doing, and a number of church mission boards are interested in supporting us.

Last week I went to prison!! I preached to a group of ISOM students. This is the same prison where we helped start ISOM six years ago. This group of twenty will be our second group of graduates at the Associates degree level. A number of the students began ISOM as Muslims, attending because they wanted a degree. Now they are saved and on-fire for Jesus!!

The last week of September, I attended an ISOM conference in California. It was very encouraging to hear missionaries from every continent and numerous nations talking about how much they appreciate the ISOM semester which includes our preaching course. It is now being used in hundreds of schools and locations.


Two of the delegates were Chinese and have been using ISOM to train 30,000 leaders in the underground church. These leaders are over fifty million believers. Our Nation-2-Nation semester will soon be available in Mandarin, and will be used to further train these leaders!!!

The last night they held a banquet, and raised funds to send small, solar-powered, video-projectors to over **two hundred remote** "end of the earth" locations. The projectors are the size of your wallet, can show a strong 5 x 5 foot picture, and come with three microchips containing ISOM, an evangelistic film, and **our own community development materials!** The plan is to reach 20,000 remote locations, in dozens of languages, by the year 2020.

Sara's been in China for almost two years now. Her ministry and language learning are really going well. We are excited because she'll be home with us for Christmas! Benjamin is enjoying his engineering classes at Texas Tech, even though they are quite challenging. Josiah is traveling with us, working on school work, and manning our ministry display in the churches.

It is only because of your help and partnership that we are able to equip pastors and church workers to minister, evangelize, and to bring their communities out of poverty. Thanks so much for your encouragement and prayers!!
